Here are some ideas and plans we have in mind.

- In the very near future, as soon as the sun comes out, I have a two day ride to eat in the MS and AR Delta planned. If you like Tamales for lunch and fantastic steak for dinner and then listening to the blues before bedding down for the night, stay tuned. With as much notice as possible (about a week) I will send out the details. THIS will be a great two days of riding.
- Another great three day, two night ride coming at the end of March or first of April is planned. This ride is called the Mississippi 1,000 N 3. Basically, this ride starts in Meridian, then to Pascagoula, Pearlington and then we bed down in a haunted mansion in St Francisville, LA.
