

This info has been here for months and is still good info.

- Riding season is here so it is time to get ready for some local riding and maybe even great memorable longer trips

 So this month's tip is ABOUT SERVICE: 1 Make sure you keep service records and conduct regular moto inspections. Always know when it is time service your bike and when to change brake pads and tires. Make plans accordingly because for example some of us may be planning long trips that may require a service on the road. If you know how, you could service the bike yourself and call ahead to a dealer so they can be expecting you. The BMW MOA has a list of all BMW dealers.
- This tip is good forever and comes from the BMW Owners News. You are never too
 old to get additional rider training and the Jan-Feb magazine had a lot of ideas of
 places to receive this training. Some will be hands on day classes and there is one
 on-line class. Also MOA will give some reimbursement on some. This is another
